### **The Faroe Islands**

- Eighteen main islands in a total number of 750
- A self-governing dependency of Denmark
- The location is between Iceland and the Shetland Islands in the North Atlantic Ocean
- Main islands are connected by road tunnels, ferries, causeways and bridges
- Natural vegetation is moss, grass, and mountain bog; naturally treeless due to cool summers, strong westerly winds, and frequent gales
- The population is 54,557 people: many are descendants of Norwegian Vikings
- Fishing is the main source of income.
- The language is Faroese Old Norse; Danish is the official second language














#### GREENLAND
