The Eagle

In the summer, golden eagles soar over Lake Louise – symbols of the expansiveness of this Central Rockies ecosystem. The eagles that summer here don't migrate great distances. However, each spring and fall at least 6000 eagles pass through Banff and Jasper national parks. They are migrating between breeding territories in the north and winter habitat in the western plains from southern Alberta to northern Mexico.


In the life of the eagle, geographic borders do not exist. To protect this mountain ecosystem, we need to take our direction from the eagle and manage beyond the boundaries of the national parks.




