Four GA Islands in Three Days

Cumberland, Jekyll, St Simons, Sapelo -October 28-October 30, 2025

The islands of Georgia are worth exploring. Each is unique. On this trip, you will get some good ideas of places to take family and friends when they visit.

On the first day, we motor to St Mary's, GA, and catch a ferry to Cumberland Island, a National Seashore where wild horses roam freely, and the ruins of the Carnegie Estate tell of a bygone era. It is a great place for photos, wildlife observation, and seeing dunes as high as the sky!

We have private guides who know the island well and will make the day meaningful as you leisurely explore it. A box lunch will be provided. The trip requires you to be able to walk up to 3 miles during the 4 hours we are at Cumberland.

Back on the mainland, we will stop in St Mary's for dinner (on your own) at a local favorite. The food is good, and the price is reasonable.

We overnight both nights at the Home2Suites on Jekyll Island. After breakfast on day 2, a trolley tour of the Jekyll Historic District tells of the island's Gilded Age, when it was the playground for America's wealthiest and most powerful families.

Then, you will go to Jekyll Island Village to shop and have lunch (on your own). The afternoon will be spent on St. Simons Island, seeing the town with stops at historic sites, Christ Church and Fort Frederica. Dinner will be at Halyard's, one of St. Simons' premiere restaurants.

After breakfast on day three, we motor to Meridian, GA, and ferry to Sapelo Island, where time stands still. Tour the unspoiled island on a school bus, learn about its history, experience the Geeche culture, and enjoy a southern feast prepared by one of the best cooks on this side of the Mississippi.
