SOME SAVVY TRAVEL TIPS FOR A SUCCESSFUL VACATION





- Leftover grocery store bags can be used to wrap your shoes in them before packing your suitcase.
- Slow quick-handed pickpockets by connecting your bag's zippers together with wire twist ties.


